WHAT IS READING FOR SURE?

Reading For Sure™ was created in 1991 by Dr Julia Solomon; a clinical psychologist and educator here in Western Australia.

She saw the need to offer a better way for students to learn to read and be literate. Her success with this innovative method meant she quickly recognized the need to train more teachers. This would then enable her to meet the needs of more students.

After 25 years, the need for reading instruction has not diminished, as there are a vast number of students not attaining literacy by the conventional methodology in the school system.

CODED PHONICS

The **Solomon method** of teaching uses a unique code system and specialized teaching methods to systematically introduce and simplify the English language to students with a wide range of difficulties, which stop them from attaining full literacy.

This method reduces anxiety and gives students the skills required to read and write the English language. For some, it is the first time they have enjoyed the reading process.

WHO CAN BE A TUTOR?

The comprehensive materials used to remediate the reading process and the training provided means that becoming a tutor may be an option for you.
